

JOINT NATIONAL CONVENTION OF ALL CENTRAL PUBLIC SECTOR UNDERTAKING WORKERS INVITATION




While the demands being pursued are common in character, the ones directly concerning the Central Public Sector employees are: Stoppage of disinvestment in central profit making PSUs; No contractorisation of work of permanent/perennial nature and payment of wages and benefits to the contract workers at the same rate as available to the regular workers of the industry/establishment.

As per decision of the National Convention of Workers held on 7th September, 2011 at New Delhi, the United Platform of All Trade Unions has given a call for one day nationwide strike on 28th February 2012. Now to work out ways and means to ensure participation of all the Central Public Sector Undertaking employees along with the entire working class of the country in the strike on 28th February 2012 and also to consider current most urgent issues of CPSU workers 'A JOINT NATIONAL CONVENTION OF ALL CENTRAL PUBLIC SECTOR UNDERTAKING WORKERS' has been fixed for 13th January, 2012 at Bangalore.

On 13th January 2012 the Convention shall commence from 10 A.M. and expected to be over by 5 P.M. The details of the address of the convention venue at Bangalore shall be intimated shortly.


