Dear Comrades,

The three day Central Executive Committee meeting of BSNL Employees Union was held at Chennai from 22nd to 24th March, 2011, under the Presidentship of Com. VAN Namboodiri. The meeting had much significance since it was held after the Fifth membership verification and also under the present deteriorating financial condition of BSNL. Further, the first day of the meeting, ie 22nd March, marked the 10th anniversary of the foundation of BSNLEU. The reception committee distributed sweets and bursted crackers to celebrate the victory of BSNLEU in the fifth membership verification and also the tenth anniversary of BSNLEU's foundation.

The CEC meeting was inaugurated by Com. A. K. Padmanabhan, All India President, CITU. In his speech, Com. A. K. Padmanabhan touched upon the international and national developments and also the important duties to be fulfilled by the trade union movement of BSNL. There was a Seminar in the afternoon of the first day, which was addressed among others by Shri A. Subramanian, CGMT, Chennai circle and Com. Amanullah Khan, All India President, AIEA. Both the speakers effectively presented their views. There was a colourful cultural programme organized by the reception committee on the first day evening.

All office bearers and Circle Secretaries spoke in detail on the report presented by the General Secretary and also on other burning issues. Valuable suggestions were placed by the CEC members on the question of BSNL's financial viability and also on improving the quality of services. Resolutions were adopted on the following issues.

1. Congratulating and thanking the workers for electing the BSNLEU in the fifth membership verification.
2. Condemning the invasion on Libya by the United States and other Western Powers.
3. Opposing VRS.
4. Demanding immediate settlement of important pending demands.
5. Financial viability of BSNL.
6. On 2G Spectrum scam.
7. On forthcoming Assembly Elections.
8. On February 23rd workers March to Parliament.
9. Thanking the Reception Committee.


IMPORTANT DECISIONS OF THE CEC MEETING

- (1) Taking into consideration the views expressed and suggestions given in the CEC meeting, the CHQ was directed to take every possible step to restore the financial viability of BSNL, as well as to improve the quality of services. It was decided to form "Save BSNL" committees at all levels. In this regard it was also decided to severely oppose the retrograde recommendations of the Board for Reconstruction of Public Sector Enterprises. (BRPSE)
- (2) It was decided that all circles should complete their collection of Building Fund by April end. Donations should be collected atleast from 50% of the paid members and sent to the CHQ immediately.
- (3) It was decided that hereafter all nominations to the Local councils should be sent only through the circle secretaries.
- (4) Com. Bhikha Ram Vishnoi from Jodhpur (Rajasthan Circle) was unanimously elected as All India Organising Secretary, against the vacant post.
- (5) It was decided to take up with the management, the issue of raising the monthly premium of GSLI to Rs.300/- for the Non-Executives.
- (6) Conferences are to be completed within next 6 months.
- (7) Circle Secretaries are directed to ensure that district secretaries remit quota to CHQ regularly and properly.
- (8) Electronic systems should be used to keep our leaders updated at all levels. Efforts should be made to issue regular circulars /bulletins/Journals.
- (9) It was decided to organise Trade Union classes.
- (10) The next meeting of CEC will be hosted by Rajasthan Circle.
- (11) The CEC directed CHQ to make all efforts to bring back NFTE & FNT0 into the fold of JAC.

At a very short notice the Tamil Nadu Circle Union and the Chennai Circle Union jointly hosted the CEC meeting. Excellent arrangements had been made for the meeting, which were appreciated by all the CEC members .CHQ heartily congratulates both the circle unions.
