



IN NATIONAL CONVENTION OF WORKERS ON 7TH
SEPTEMBER, 2011 AT MAVALANKAR HALL, NEW DELHI.**


The Central Trade Union Organisations in their meeting on 4th August, 2011 under the chairmanship of Dr. G. Sanjeev Reddy, MP, and President, INTUC have decided to hold National Convention of Workers on 7th September, 2011 at Mavalankar Hall, New Delhi to chalk out next phase of Joint Struggle over the commonly agreed demands of working people. The Convention will begin at 10.30 a.m.

The meeting recalled that working people of the country have already launched joint struggles including General Strike on 7th September, 2010, against price rise, violation of labour laws, outsourcing and contractisation, job losses, disinvestment of Government equity and diluting its control and hold on the public sector enterprises and non creation of National Fund for social security for unorganised workers. The CTUOs expressed deep concern over the inaction of the Government to take into account the issues relating to the distressed working masses.

The Central Trade Unions call upon its constituents and appeal to the National Federations of employees and workers and Independent Unions to participate in this National Convention of workers.




