Sub: - JAO Part-II exam - requesting to grant one time relaxation – reg.

Ref: - Our letter No. BSNLEU/527 (JAO) dated 30-03-2010.

With reference to the letter no. cited above I once again wish to draw your kind attention to the subject.

As has already been brought to your notice, the JAO part-II Departmental Exam, both 40% and 10% was held from 4th to 6th January, 2010. In most of the circles results are already declared. As per the reports that we have received from the field units, a large number of vacancies remain unfilled, because of low percentage of passing. This was largely due to the wrong questions and out of the syllabus questions asked in the exam. It can also be seen that a large number of candidates have failed by just a few marks, which is due to very strict valuation.

I wish to once again bring to your notice that the JAO exam was not conducted for the past so many years. Our union has been consistently urging upon the management to hold the exam. By the time the exam is conducted, so many precious years have passed away and this inordinate delay has its own impact on the performance of the candidates who appeared the exam. Had this exam been held a few years ago, the performance of the same candidates would have been definitely better than this. This factor may be appropriately taken into consideration by the management. Further, I also request you to kindly keep in mind that this was the last chance for the departmental candidates to appear the exam in the old syllabus.

It is pertinent to mention here that the management has given grace marks to the extent of 10% to the failed candidates of the TTA Direct Recruitment. There can be no two opinions that this was done only to fill up more number of vacancies. Now the simple question that arises is that, when the management was so kind and considerate to the outside

candidates, why the same kindness and consideration is not being shown to the internal candidates who had toiled all these years for the betterment of this organization? The two different yardsticks being adopted by the management - one for the outside candidates and another for the internal candidates – is definitely creating heart burning among the employees who have put in long years of service.

I request you to kindly take all these factors into consideration and render justice to the internal candidates by granting grace marks to the extent of 10% to 15%.


I am enumerating hereunder, the complaints that we have received from field units, in respect of wrong and out of syllabus questions:-

1. As per Circular No.4-29/2003-SEA(BSNL) dated 12/10/2009 it was specifically mentioned in Subject-I Paper II will be practical paper whereas all the questions asked in the Paper II were theory questions.
2. In the above subject in “Section ‘A’ ” question No.1 to 4 are pertaining to Telecom Accounts II i.e. Paper III.
3. In Paper I Theory Question No.1 Sub question 1 to 8 ($2 \frac{1}{2} \times 8 = 20$ marks) pertains to Telecom Accounts II i.e. Paper III.
4. In Paper I Theory Question No.4 Sub Question 1 to 8 ($2 \frac{1}{2} \times 8 = 20$ marks) pertains to Telecom Accounts II i.e. Paper III.
5. In Paper No.V Civil Works as per page No.5 Para No.1 of Question Paper assessed value of Bricks was given Rs.320 per % (i.e. 100 Bricks) it is contrary as detailed below:

In the First Running Account Bill it was stated Rs.120000/- was granted as Secured Advance for 500000 (5 Lakh) Bricks as worked out below. Assessed value Rs.320.75% of Assessed value is $240.240 \times 500000 / 1000 = \text{Rs.}120000$. This mistake committed in the question paper created confusion among the candidates.
