Sub: One time 2 years relaxation in the qualifying service condition in the ensuing 35% and 15% JTO LICE – req.

Sir,

You are well aware of the fact that the demand of the staff side in National Council Meeting was always for (five) years qualifying service condition in 35% & 15% JTO LICE. The demand was on the basis of the DOP&T order No.14017/2/97-Estt. (RR) dated 25th May, 1998 and AO.14017/61/2008-Estt. (RR) dated 24th March, 2009.


Based on the demand of the staff side an amendment is made to the Recruitment Rules to reduce the qualifying service condition to 7 years from 10 years, but the situation in the various circles warrant further relaxation of 2 years in the qualifying service condition to make eligible all the TTA who recruited directly against the outside vacancies for the year 2000. Since the then direct recruitment examination in TTA cadre was conducted independently by Telecom Circles, there is a gap of 6 months to a year in the service of the TTAs recruited in different circles, which will deprive them of the chance to appear in the ensuing JTO LICE.

It is calculated that only a few hundreds directly recruited TTAs will be eligible for LICE if 7 years service condition is not relaxed where as large number of vacancies will be available for the said examination. In some circles like NE-I, Uttaranchal etc. not a single direct recruited TTA will be eligible.

On the above context, I request you to grant one time 2 years relaxation in the qualifying service condition in the ensuing JTO LICE to allow maximum number of officials to appear.
