Sub: - **One time Relaxation / concession in JAO Part-II Departmental Examination – req.**

Sir,

The JAO Part-II Departmental Examination, both 40% and 10%, have been held from 04<sup>th</sup> to 06<sup>th</sup> January, 2010, as a one time measure and as a last chance for the departmental candidates in old syllabus. The results are also declared in most of the circles. We have come to understand that the percentage of passing is very less due to the wrong questions/ out of syllabus questions and also due to very strict valuation. We have received a lot of complaints from our members regarding the wrong questions asked in the exam. The following are some of the complaints that we have received:-

- 1) As per Circular No.4-29/2003-SEA(BSNL) dated 12/10/2009 it was specifically mentioned in Subject-I Paper II will be practical paper whereas all the questions asked in the Paper II were theory questions.
- 2) In the above subject in "Section 'A' " question No.1 to 4 are pertaining to Telecom Accounts II i.e. Paper III.
- 3) In Paper I Theory Question No.1 Sub question 1 to 8 (2 ½ X 8 = 20 marks) pertains to Telecom Accounts II i.e. Paper III.
- 4) In Paper I Theory Question No.4 Sub Question 1 to 8 (2 ½ X 8 = 20 marks) pertains to Telecom Accounts II i.e. Paper III.

5) In Paper No.V Civil Works as per page No.5 Para No.1 of Question Paper assessed value of Bricks was given Rs.320 per % (i.e. 100 Bricks) it is contrary as detailed below:

In the First Running Account Bill it was stated Rs.120000/- was granted as Secured Advance for 500000 (5 Lakh) Bricks as worked out below. Assessed value Rs.320.75% of Assessed value is  $240.240 \times 500000 / 1000 = \text{Rs.}120000$ . This mistake committed in the question paper created confusion among the candidates.


It is also understood that a good number of candidates could not qualify the examination for want of just a few marks, resulting in a large number of departmental vacancies remaining unfilled. Taking the decades of services rendered by these departmental candidates and also their age factor into account, a relaxation of 10% to 15% marks may kindly be extended to the candidates, of both 40% and 10% quota. This will help to fill up the vacancies and will also benefit the employees.

It may not be irrelevant to mention here, that during the recruitment of TTAs from outside candidates, a concession and relaxation of 10% marks had been extended to the failed candidates, to facilitate filling up of the vacancies.

In view of the above, I request you that a relaxation of 10% to 15% marks may kindly be extended to the departmental candidates, who appeared the JAO exam, against 40% and 10% quota.
