Sub: 40% Limited Departmental Competitive Exam for TTA – Holding of Pre-qualifying test – req.

I wish to bring the following to your kind notice, for favour of necessary action.

BSNL has intimated a scheme, vide letter no. 1st cited hereinabove, in respect of 40% LDCA for the cadre of TTA. The letter has not stated anything with regards to the continuation of the 'Pre-Qualification Test', in respect of those candidates who are not possessing 10+2 qualification. This has created a confusion.

I wish to bring to your kind notice that based on the agreement reached with the Recognised Union in the 2nd National Council meeting, held on 28.05.2003, BSNL, vide its letter no. 2nd cited hereinabove, issued instruction to hold 'Pre-Qualification Test', for those candidates who do not possess 10+2 qualification. Based on this order, one LDCE exam and one more supplementary exam have been conducted. This system of holding a 'Pre-Qualifying' Test has certainly benefited quite a good number of officials, who otherwise would not have become eligible to appear the LDCE.

It is our apprehension that the management has given a go-by to this system. If it is so, it is unfair. Since the decision was taken based on the agreement reached with the Recognised Union in the National Council, it is not fair on the part of the management to arbitrarily rescind the same without consulting the Recognised Union.

It is our firm view that the system of holding 'Pre-Qualification Test' should not be discontinued, as it will shut the door to officials who do not possess the academic qualification of 10 +2, but otherwise capable of becoming TTAs. I request you to kindly look into this and do the needful.
